Roosevelt Island Bus Trip

Bus leaves the Garden at 8 a.m. and returns approximately 6 p.m.

Join us on Wednesday, October 10th, when we will again be under the “spell” of the wonderful **New York historian, Joyce Gold.**

Joyce meets us at 10:00 a.m. on Roosevelt Island for a two-hour walking tour. “From Madmen and Criminals to Innovation Hotspot” – Joyce’s description of present-day Roosevelt Island. Set in the middle of the East River, Roosevelt Island, after being bought by the City, was used for 100 years to house the unsavory services of prison and madhouse. In the last few decades, it has become a thriving mixed income town. You will see, among other things, the new **Cornell-Technion Institute**, the **Four Freedoms Park**, **Roosevelt Island tramway**, and **spectacular views of Manhattan**. So put on your walking shoes and join us!

At approximately 12:30 p.m., we board our bus and head to the famous **Park Side Restaurant**, an Italian landmark located in the heart of Corona, Queens, and one of the finest food destinations for years. Our luncheon will be served in a private room upstairs from the restaurant proper. NOTE: there is a stairway but no elevator. Our menu consists of a pasta with Bolognese sauce; a mixed greens salad with vine ripened cherry tomatoes in a balsamic vinaigrette, an entrée choice of broiled wild Atlantic salmon, veal scallopine, or chicken scarpariello (mixed on and off the bone). Dessert is an occasion cake, and coffee, espresso or tea. Soda, beer or wine will be served during lunch.

The bus leaves Clark Botanic Garden promptly at 8:00 a.m. and returns at approximately 6:00 p.m. The trip goes forward “rain or shine”, and the cost is \$120 for members and \$135 for non-members or guests.
